#### The Aim

#### Together with the EEF NFs:

- To identify and educate people with potential to become national dressage judges
- To setup a network for education and cooperation of the national dressage officials
- To provide opportunities for judging on videos and during real events
- To support the identified official who cover the FEI entry level to become judges in their pathway to international judges.

#### The certification is a full responsibility of the NFs of the participants.

It is up to the NF decide if people who take part at the program will be certify as national Judges and at what level. EEF will not provide certification.



#### Role of EEF

EEF undertakes to help NFs that are parties to the convention to meet and maintain the minimum educational standards, by means of:

- Training
- Advice
- Providing education material
- Other appropriate support and
- Regular assessments

#### 1. Announcement of the program

- Information sent to EEF NFs, Facebook groups, IDOC, IDTC...
- Opening of online registration process
- Application form will provide information about the experience and the goals of candidates

#### 2. Preliminary online education

- Preliminary evaluation with online judging of a test
- The focus will be education for the level which is at these regions – children, juniors and St. George

- Opening of online registration process
- Application done by the NFs

#### 2. Preliminary online education

#### 3. Video's judging

Blackhorse-one.com video judging

• videos – for each participants



#### 4. Selection of the candidates / mentors

Based on evaluation at phases 1-3

- The candidates will be in groups based on the geographic representation.
- The selected candidates will be allocated in groups to mentors.

#### 6. In-person educational course

2 in-person courses for each group will be organized for the selected candidates

#### 7. Real judging opportunities under the mentors observation

- Participants to judge under mentors supervision
- Invitation at shows at the country of the mentors

#### **Shadowjudging**

 At national shows – live comments, the participants will listen the live comments from the judge(s)



#### **Assessments**

- Online test for assessment will be developed
- Before phase 1 for preliminary evaluation of the candidate judges
- After Phase 3 for selection of the candidates
- After Phase 7 for measuring of the success

At every stage the results will be shared with participant NF.

The certification is a full responsibility of the NFs of the participants.
